

ORDINANCE NO. 9 , 2009

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE  
BOARD OF TAX REVIEW**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Tax Review is a Board appointed by the Council pursuant to the Code of Ordinances and the laws of the State of Ohio principally for the purposes of hearing appeals from determinations made by the Tax Commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of office for members of the Board of Tax Review currently is an unlimited term appointed by City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, to provide consistency in the appointment of the various Boards and Commissions, Council does desire to establish specific terms of office for members of the Board of Tax Review.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Tax Review shall consist of three members who are residents of the City. The members shall be appointed by Council to serve three year staggered terms commencing February 1 in the appropriate year of appointment. Vacancies to the Board shall be filled by Council for the unexpired term in the manner in which the original appointment was made.

**SECTION 2.** With the adoption of this Ordinance, to transition to the new three year terms members shall be appointed to fill staggered terms. One member shall be appointed for a term of office expiring January 31, 2011, a second member shall be appointed to a term expiring January 31, 2012, and the third member shall be appointed to a term expiring January 31, 2013. Thereafter, the successor to each of these terms

shall serve a three year term. Members may be appointed and reappointed without a limit on the number of terms which they may serve.

**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
