

ORDINANCE NO. 14 , 2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, FIELD OPERATIONS TO PROVIDE FIRE HYDRANT REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE CITY

WHEREAS, contracting for the purchase of material, equipment or services which will exceed \$50,000.00 requires competitive bidding under the Municipal Charter and Ohio law; and

WHEREAS, Ohio law recognizes certain exceptions to the requirements for competitive bidding including purchase from another political subdivision pursuant to R.C. § 735.053; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton County, Ohio, through the Hamilton County Department of Planning and Development, Field Operations, has offered to provide fire hydrant repair services for the City of Montgomery, which for calendar year 2014 the Administration estimates will exceed \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County previously, by Resolution adopted December 5, 2012, did authorize an Agreement with the City of Montgomery for such fire hydrant repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Administration does desire to ratify the terms and conditions of such 2012 contract, a copy of which is attached hereto with the County's authorizing Resolution, and to expand such contract to provide such repair services and materials as needed in calendar year 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Council hereby ratifies the terms and conditions of the attached Agreement between the Board of County Commissions, Hamilton County, Ohio and the City of Montgomery dated December 11, 2012, and authorizes the City Manager to execute such Agreement to extend this Agreement to provide fire hydrant repair services for the City for calendar year 2014 in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00.

SECTION 2. This contract is authorized pursuant to R.C. § 735.053, which allows the purchase of materials and services from another political subdivision of the State without public, competitive bidding.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
