**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RAY KINGSBURY FOR
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO COMMUNICATIONS, PUBLIC
RELATIONS, AND CITIZEN OUTREACH**

WHEREAS, Section 9.03 of Article IX of the Charter of the City of Montgomery, Ohio, provides the method under which the City Manager shall make certain purchases and enter into contracts on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to provide contract authority for professional services that are generally not subject to competitive bidding but will exceed a total of \$25,000 in a calendar year; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the City of Montgomery to enter into a contract with Ray Kingsbury for calendar year 2010 to provide communications, public relations, and citizen outreach services for the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ray Kingsbury for professional services to be provided to the City of Montgomery for the year 2010 according to the proposal submitted by Ray Kingsbury attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to pay Ray Kingsbury according to the rates set forth in said schedule.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
