

RESOLUTION NO. 27 , 2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MORTON INTERNATIONAL, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF DE-ICING ROCK SALT PURSUANT TO A JOINT PURCHASING BID

WHEREAS, R. C. §9.48 permits municipalities to participate in a joint purchasing program with other political subdivisions, which purchase may be made without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cincinnati has advertised for bids for the purchase of de-icing rock salt, which bid includes the right of other municipalities to participate in such purchase; and

WHEREAS, under the authority granted by R. C. §9.48, the City of Montgomery does desire to participate in such joint purchasing bid with the City of Cincinnati and other communities to acquire de-icing rock salt from Morton International, Inc. for the coming winter season without the need for competitive bid; and

WHEREAS, the city Administration has determined that this is the most cost effective and efficient method for acquiring such de-icing rock salt.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Morton International, Inc. through the City of Cincinnati's cooperative bid, without further advertisement and without competitive bidding to purchase de-icing rock salt at \$61.56 per ton for dump delivery for the 2011-2012 winter season.

SECTION 2. The maximum amount which may be expended for such purchase during the winter season shall be \$92,500.00.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
