

RESOLUTION NO. 35 , 2011

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BID AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN BUS AND ACCESSORIES, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS THROUGH THE COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Montgomery through the Police Department did make application to the United States Department of Justice for a Secure our Schools – Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Grant, which grant was awarded by the City in the total amount of \$87,309.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant application was submitted in cooperation with the Sycamore Community School District (“District”) to fund the purchase of security equipment to be used by the District in partnership with the Montgomery Police Department to enhance safety in the Sycamore Schools; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the grant, the City of Montgomery must purchase equipment to be used by the District and contract with the District to lease such equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding, a copy of which previously has been filed with the Clerk of Council, outlining the terms under which the grant will be administered and the equipment acquired by the City and used by the District; and

WHEREAS, the City has advertised for bids for the purchase of video recording systems and additional hard drives which may be integrated into the security systems currently in place within the District; and


WHEREAS, the City has received a bid from American Bus and Accessories, Inc., which the administration has determined to be the lowest and best bid, and which the administration with the District recommends acceptance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The bid of \$70,217.06 received from American Bus and Accessories, Inc. for the purchase of video recording camera systems and additional hard drives is hereby accepted and Council does authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract for such purchase. This purchase shall be appropriately funded through the Secure Our Schools – COPS Grant awarded to the City.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
