A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF  
MAY, 2011 AS NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH  
IN THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY

**WHEREAS**, the City of Montgomery has a rich heritage which is manifested in numerous buildings throughout the City, including eight buildings listed in the National Historic Register; and

**WHEREAS**, this heritage enriches the lives of our citizens, and it is in the public interest to preserve this legacy so that future generations may benefit from the cultural, aesthetic, educational, economic and inspirational benefits of their heritage; and

**WHEREAS**, the retention of the City of Montgomery's heritage is best accomplished only through the combined efforts of concerned individuals and organizations in the community.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The City of Montgomery does hereby designate the month of May, 2011 as ***National Historic Preservation Month*** in the City of Montgomery. The City of Montgomery is proud to be home to many authentic architectural representations of the City's historic cultural heritage which we celebrate throughout the year, but particularly within this month. We call special attention to the Montgomery Landmarks that have been carefully researched and recognized by the Landmarks Commission and the collection of our community history assembled by the Montgomery Historical Preservation Association at the Wilder Swaim House.

**SECTION 2.** We hereby call upon all citizens to recognize our City's historical past, and to protect these precious resources for the enjoyment of future generations.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
