

RESOLUTION NO. 35 , 2014

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE
HAMILTON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR
BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 2015, 2016, AND 2017**

WHEREAS, the City of Montgomery held a public hearing on September 25, 2014 to solicit ideas on the community development priorities within the City and held a second public hearing on October 20, 2014 to discuss projects to address those priorities; and

WHEREAS, based on the results of these hearings the City has determined that the top priority is to address blighting conditions caused by long neglected, deteriorating, and functionally obsolete buildings in the downtown historic district and Old Montgomery Gateway District; and

WHEREAS, Council does desire to apply to the Hamilton County Department of Development for grant funding to address these issues.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to make application to the Hamilton County Department of Development for community development block grant funds for the demolition of the building at 9260 Montgomery Road and associated site clean-up. The amount of this grant application shall not exceed \$ 100,000.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
