

RESOLUTION NO. 38 , 2014

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON THE COLLECTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT FUND FEES

WHEREAS, Chapter 153.05 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Montgomery created an Environmental Impact Fund and set a Schedule of Fees for both residential and commercial construction to be paid into such Fund; and

WHEREAS, Council did previously enact an extension to the moratorium suspending the payments of such fees until October 31, 2014 to support economic recovery in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has reviewed the current structure of the Environmental Impact Fund and significantly changed such structure to comply with Ohio law; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended continuing such moratorium until the new structure has been legislatively approved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The current fee structure established under Chapter 153.05 of the Code of Ordinances payable to the Environmental Impact Fund shall be suspended until February 28, 2015 or such earlier date as substitute legislation shall take effect replacing the current collection procedure.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
