

Dear Paintball participant,

Thank you for registering for the School's Out Paintball Trip. Below are details about the trip:

Where & When to meet:

-The trip is on Friday, October 26, 2018.

-Meet & return from Swaim Park upper level parking lot on Cooper road. The address is 7650 Cooper Road, Montgomery 45242.

-The time of the trip is 9:00 a.m. to approximately 5:00 p.m. If we encounter an unforeseen delay in returning from the trip (ie. traffic) we will contact parents on the emergency contact phone number to give an update on our return time.

-Transportation is by bus.

What to bring:

-A signed Paintball Country waiver is required in order to participate. Please return the Paintball Country waiver with your child on the day of the trip or you may also drop off a copy or mail in a copy prior to the trip at City Hall at 10101 Montgomery Rd. Monday through Friday 7:30 am to 5pm. Paintball Country will not let a participant play paintball without the waiver form. There are no exceptions.

-Please bring extra drinks. Since we will be active, bringing a lot of liquids like water would be beneficial. A pizza lunch, snacks and drinks are provided. You may bring an extra snack if you wish. There is a concession area, so participants may bring extra money if they wish to buy items from that concession area. Please be sure to keep money secure while we are at Paintball Country. A couple of participants in the past accidentally lost their money while at Paintball Country due to the activity during the day.

What to wear:

-Dress in comfortable clothing and shoes since we will be active during paintball and other fun activities at Paintball Country and participants may be running, jumping, crawling and getting dirty outdoors. Participants may want to wear long pants and long-sleeved shirt. Wearing multiple layers is best for extra padding and participants may want to wear dark clothing for hiding purposes. Many kids wear a "hoodie" for the extra protection it provides for the head and ears. Gloves are also recommended, and a regular pair of winter gloves would be good. The paint is supposed to wash off clothing.

Who to contact:

-The trip is led by the City of Montgomery Recreation staff. Contact information is: **Sarah Fink, Recreation Specialist, 513-792-8317, Cell Phone for Day of Trip is: 513-297-8297.** Two City of Montgomery Police Officers and the recreational coordinator will chaperone the trip as well.

-We are headed to: Paintball Country, 5110 LeSourdsville West Chester Rd, Hamilton, Ohio 45011. Their phone is 513-779-3228 and we will be there for the paintball game and other fun activities they have at their site.

Other paintball information:

-Participants will be required to wear a helmet with a facemask that is provided by Paintball Country during the game for safety reasons. Staff at Paintball Country will explain the rules to participants such as not being able to shoot within 10 feet of a person and if you call "out" you are out etc. There will be a referee from Paintball Country monitoring and leading our play.

- Paintball guns are provided to all participants. If you wish to bring your own gun, semi automatic guns are the only type that is allowed.

-If it is storming on the day of the trip, the trip may be cancelled. Please contact us for further details.
